Boating is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the Hamble River Raid, competitors agree and acknowledges that:

they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the Hamble River Raid;

they are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;

they accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;

their boat is in good order, equipped to compete in the Hamble River Raid and they and their crew are fit to participate;

the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the Organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;

the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

it is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event referred to in the Notice or Race and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue;

they will not participate in the Hamble River Raid if under the influence of alcohol, drugs or if otherwise unfit to participate;

they are responsible for ensuring that their boat is equipped and seaworthy so as to be able to face conditions expected during the Hamble River Raid, that there is a crew sufficient in number, experience and fitness to withstand the event;

their boat is adequately insured for racing;

they will comply at all times with the event rules listed on the event website

they will inform the Organiser if there have been any changes to the information provided on this form at the time of the Event.

Terms

You understand that the organiser may cancel or postpone the Hamble River Raid at any stage in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise.

We regret that we are unable to provide refunds, however if it is not possible to run the race, or you are unable to attend due to COVID, we will transfer you entry to the next race.

Misconduct

You understand that the organiser may exclude anyone from a Hamble River Raid who refuses to comply with these terms or who misconducts themselves in any way or who causes damage or annoyance to other persons.

DATA PROTECTION

The information you provide in his form will be used to facilitate your participation in the Hamble River Raid and to contact you regarding the Hamble River Raid or future Hamble River Raids.
